### A Humble Beginning

This is a true story of one man's determination and collective efforts of like minded philanthropists devoted to the noble cause of imparting education to the next generation. Today these efforts have turned into a magnificent educational institution - **RAMJI ASSAR VIDYALAYA.**

Sheth Shri Ramji Assar established a primary co-education school in June 1911. The very fact that this was a co-education school was again a rare phenomenon in those days. After the demise of Shri Ramji Assar, his wife Smt. Navibai Ramji Assar took upon herself the noble work of educating the future generation.

In the year 1928 Shri Morarji Vasanji donated good amount to start Balamandir to impart education on the basis of Montessori system in Gujarati medium with just six students. With the changing scenario and with English medium gaining popularity Ramji Assar Vidyalaya gave an option to the Gujarati medium students of std VIII to select English or Gujarati as their medium of instruction. This led to the birth of Ramji Assar Vidyalaya English medium Secondary school in the year 1965 and in the same year Ramji Assar Vidyalaya English medium Primary school.

In the year 1972 we were fortunate in having a generous donor Shri. Dharamsy Morarji Bhatia to start a full fledged English medium secondary school which was named after his wife, Smt. Manibai Dharamsy Bhatia. In the year 1975 the Primary school was named after Shri. Dharamsy Morarji Bhatia.

On 26<sup>th</sup> Jan 1975, Ramji Assar Vidyalaya's Valimandal was established which works for the welfare of the students.

In the year 2012, "AARAV (Alumni Association of Ramji Assar Vidyalaya) was formed and it conducts various activities for the students.

The horizon of learning is endless, the avenues myriad and we can only hope that in our humble mission we provide an adequate base for every child to discover his capabilities. In the hustle of life in a crowded world, we develop children's individual potential so that they find their own grove in the endless possibilities life has to offer that leave their mark not on sand, but on stone. Moving with time, we propose to have a new building with new infrastructure to cater to the needs of the changing time like a well equipped library, modern laboratory, computers in every class etc.

I feel proud to note that the M. D. Bhatians as popularly known are excelling in all fields. The young cricketers had been a winner of Harris Shield and Giles shield. Volley ball, Chess, Karate are the other fields in which our students are excelling. The far sightedness, quick thinking and the demonic urge for progress has led to the institution's success in all walks of life. In the last few years, we have been able to etch our name amongst the best schools in Ghatkopar with 100% result in S.S.C year after year. I am sure that the publication of **mdbhatia news** will be a very effective medium to showcase the talents of the students and also to educate the community at large. ### A tribute to Dr. Abdul Kalam - The Missile Man

Dr. Abdul Kalam, former President of India, is considered an honorable person of our country. Born in a simple family, on 15<sup>th</sup> October 1931, Abdul Kalam turned to be a scientist and administrator. As a scientist, his service to the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is enormous. For the missile launches done under the accountability of Kalam, he is prominently called the "Missile Man of India".

He not only served as a scientist; but also spent his time lecturing students of various institutes of India. The awards and honors Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam had received were innumerable; which includes the Bharat Ratna, Ramanujan Award, Veer Savarkar Award, Padma Bhushan and Padma Vibhushan.

Such a remarkable man departed his life while delivering a lecture at IIM, Shillong, on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2015.
